New Business (6:24)

- Jacqueline has a motion to add (6:24)
- The motion entails the USC of Academics to implement a pass/fail credit available for courses in A&H.
- The USC will bring this motion to senate pass fail credit.
- It is limited to one or two credits over the course of one's time at Western.
- This would allow students to take an elective that would broaden their interest and to recruit possible minoring students in an A&H program.
- This would also alleviate some anxiety in terms of mental health with GPA.

September 27th, 2016

- Lower than 50% would be considered a fail, higher than 50% would be a pass.
- Amendment: Massimo requests that it be specified that the course must be designated as a pass/fail credit towards the end of the year.
- Majority in favor of amendment with regards to wording. Two are opposed.
- Reminder: this motion is just to show that AH supports this idea and are informed. Details will be worked out at the senate level.
- Amendment: Lyndon requests that 'advocate' is too broad and the wording needs to be changed.
- Specified that the AHSC VP of academics will advocate to the associate dean of academics.
- Majority in favor of amendment with regards to wording. One abstains.
- Majority are in favor of amendment. Two are opposed.
